

- Permanent Water Supply Points such as streams and rivers with vehicle access

Mobile Water Tankers - Two 500-liter slip on water tanks, pump and hose reel units which can be fitted onto a normal forest pickup truck. Two 6,000 liter mobile water tanks which may be towed by a 4-wd tractor and which is also fitted with a pump, suction hose and hand tools

## 10.6 Socio-Economic Consideration

### 10.6.1 Resettlement and Compensation

Section 4.3 of the ratified concession agreement between Sime Darby Plantation (Liberia) Inc and the Government of Liberia provides that Sime Darby Plantation (Liberia) Inc may by notice to GOL request that certain settlements be relocated if Investor can demonstrate to GOL that such settlement and its inhabitants would impede development in the project area. Such resettlement shall be effected with the view of minimizing the number of enclaves within the concession area. The agreement states that GOL shall bare sole responsibility for resettlement including resettlement and payment of all costs and expenses of resettlement; however, Sime Darby Plantation (Liberia) Inc shall assist GOL in effecting such resettlement plans, including the development and management of any resettlement plans and the execution of resettlement logistics; \$200.00 (as adjusted for inflation) paid per hectare of land requiring resettlement, in no event to exceed (iii) US\$3,000,000 in the aggregate amount during the entire term.

The agreement also provides the following:

- That GOL establish a resettlement committee for the purpose of supervising or advising on resettlement efforts which shall include leaders or their appointees, local community and representative of Sime Darby
- GOL cooperate with SIME DARBY to define the areas to be resettled
- GOL determine a compensation scale for resettlement costs which shall be subject to SIME DARBY approval, with such approval not to be unreasonably withheld
- GOL conduct and solely be responsible for resettlement negotiations with the local communities and settlers
- Resettlement funds (including resettlement advances) shall be held and managed in an escrow account which investor (or its representative) shall be permitted to monitor

In line with international best practices such as the Equator Principle and IFC Guidelines "Performance Standard 5-Land Acquisition and Involuntary Resettlement; people, who because of the location of their farms and/or buildings to areas needed for the project are required to be properly compensated. Definition of the compensation strategy- and all aspects of the resettlement-should be a consultative and participatory process through which affected people are consulted properly and choose for themselves from among acceptable and clearly defined alternatives.
